Responsibilities:

- 1. Assist the Production Manager for Festival's programmes and budgeting;
- 2. Manage assigned programmes in technical, production and stage management aspects;
- 3. Handle special licenses for stage productions; and
- 4. Manage technical and production inventories, organizing information lists, stock taking and warehouse maintenance.

Qualifications:

- 1. A recognized university/ academy degree in stage/ technical management, lighting design, or equivalent; with minimum 6 years of relevant experience with solid 3-years in a supervisory position as full time staff with performing arts companies, venues or arts organizations; OR
 - A recognized advance diploma or diploma in stage/ technical management, lighting design, or equivalent; with minimum 8 years of relevant experience with solid 5-years in a supervisory position as full time staff with performing arts companies, venues or arts organizations;
- 2. Proficient in computer software of Microsoft office and AutoCAD;
- 3. Strong administrative and interpersonal skills with extensive management experience in various stage productions, including management and technical operations; and
- 4. Excellent spoken and written communication skills in English and Chinese. Proficiency in Putonghua is preferred.

This is a contract post renewable on a yearly basis.
