- 2. To manage and implement all production aspects of the Outreach programmes.
- 3. To supervise the design and production of all the publicity materials and education materials of No Limits outreach programmes.
- 4. To take part in the artist liaison, coordination, promotion, implementation and execution of the programmes.

Qualifications:

- 1. University graduate or equivalent with a minimum of 3 years of relevant experience in the performing arts industry;
- 2. Strong in project management and multi-tasking, good interpersonal and communication skills with ability to work with multiple stakeholders, detail-oriented;
- 3. Ability to think strategically and creatively and carry out responsibilities independently;
- 4. A collaborative working style and hands-on work ethic;
- 5. Good command of written and spoken English and Chinese; and
- 6. Passionate in arts
